

## Environmental Policy 2010 ~ 2011

### Introduction:

Sanken Power Systems [UK] Ltd. is the European Technology Centre and wholly owned subsidiary of Sanken Electric Co. SPS's main activity is to promote the sale of Sanken Electric's key products for both the semi-conductor and power module divisions within Europe, whilst offering technical and customer support.

### General Measures:

At SPS, care for the environment is an integral part of our company strategy.

We aim to minimise our effects on the environment by adopting a pro-active approach via the following measures: -

- i. Establishing an environmental management system which meets the requirements of ISO14001:2004.
- ii. Operate a company environmental system to evaluate and improve our environmental performance.
- iii. Abide by environmental laws and regulations and voluntarily observe stricter restrictions.
- iv. Measuring utility levels and setting improvement targets.
- v. Minimise logistical aspects for air, sea and land.
- vi. Communicate our Sanken Group Action Plan to customers and stakeholders.

### Continuous Improvement Activities:

- i. Communicate our policy and objectives throughout all levels of the company inc. subcontractors.
- ii. Promote environmental awareness and train staff whose activities have a potential environmental impact.
- iii. Continuously monitor and improve the control of our environmental impacts.
- iv. Conduct internal audits to ensure our policy and objectives are being achieved.

### Specific Measures:

- i. Comply with the EU chemical legislation - Registration, Evaluation, and Authorisation of Chemicals legislation (REACH) by only allowing the use of substances that are classified as safe for the environment and used in accordance with the REACH directive.
- ii. Comply with Packaging Regulations and Producer Responsibility Obligations, by monitoring our packaging levels for products sold into the UK.
- iii. Ensure continued compliance to RoHS directive by removing hazardous substances from all products in accordance to the Sanken Environmental Std. CXA40000-505A & JIG101.
- iv. Comply with the ELVD – End of Life Vehicles Directive in accordance to the directive 2000/53/EC.
